

A God of MIRACES!

As I sit here this morning, I am again amazed at how God has answered the prayers of so many of His children at ICC.

A few weeks ago, I was very concerned that we would not have enough items, or enough money to send a container down to El Salvador for the children's needs there. Today, everything is different. These past few weeks have provided me with an opportunity to again see God creating MIRACLES through His people.

I will always remember having a phone conversation with an amazing lady in Canada as she told me about a tragedy that she recently faced in her life and the struggles her family continues to have through all of it. As she related her story to me, a tear ran down my face as my heart was touched and my prayers went out on her behalf. Then, as we closed our conversation, she told me that she was sending a very significant donation to ICC to help with the El Salvador shipment! A MIRACLE through someone's storms in life.

I remember sitting in our weekly worship ready to talk to our staff about the fact that we had not received many donations for this container and that we needed to continue to pray diligently for God's leading in what to do with this. I wondered to myself where God was leading us. As I was about to speak about this issue, our receptionist called me out of worship to take a phone call. When I picked up the phone, a kind gentleman introduced himself to me and told me that he was calling to tell me that he was sending a large donation to help pay for the El Salvador Container Project!

When I saw that El Salvador needed a tractor, I was worried. The cost of a good used one, and the chance that you will even find one that is of the type you need is remote. With only a short time to do so made it an even more daunting task for me. One week later, a couple, who are friends of mine, wrote me an email. In that email, they told me of some "extra" money that they had, and they wanted to give it to God's work for His kids. Within a week, a large portion of the money needed for the tractor purchase was in our office. When we found the tractor that would fit the bill, I was with another friend of mine and when the final price was quoted to us, it was more money than we had. Without hesitation, my friend told me, "Doug, don't worry about the extra money, I will cover that for the kids." A MIRACLE of generosity at just the right time.

I received a phone call from Joel Reyes, our administrator in El Salvador while he was on vacation in The States. He told me that he needed a special lawn mower to be used for mowing the immense grassy areas of the campus. How were we ever going to find a good used one, much less afford to fill this need? Within days, Joel called me back and told me that a wonderful family who has been so supportive of the El Salvador project, along with their personal friends, had offered to purchase a brand new industrial riding mower. A MIRACLE of filling a need from caring friends.

There are many more amazing stories of how this shipment will now take place. I wish that there was room here to tell you all of them. Please just know that everyone of you who gave for this shipment are an answer to prayers, prayers of us at ICC, but most importantly, prayers of His children in El Salvador.

It never ceases to amaze me how our God cares for His children. I never tire of seeing how His people somehow, someway, always answer His call in James 1:27 – "Take care of the orphans."

This is a container loaded with a cargo of love and hope for His children who need it so much. Because of all of you, every single one of you who continue to give for this great work at ICC, there is hope for children who otherwise would have none. I pray that each one of you knows how grateful we are at ICC, how thankful the children are, and I believe how grateful Jesus is for all that you continue to do for "His kids." Without you, this container would have never happened. Without you, there would be no ICC to provide homes of hope for those who need it so desperately. Without you, where would they go?

God bless each one of you for all that you have done, and all that you will continue to do for this special work for Him. All of you are MIRACLES!
