Dear Friend,

I have something of extreme importance to talk to you about today...

I don't know what the words "Summer Slump" mean to you, but I certainly know what they mean to the children living in the ICC Children's Villages. For the children those words mean doing without a healthy diet.

You see, fundraising and the amount of money we can send to the children goes down every summer.
