This is quite a big accomplishment for such a little fellow. And it's even more remarkable when you consider that when he came to us, he was pale and thin and malnourished.

The campus Pathfinder club provides Manual and other children a place to build skills and develop character. **The children are taught about their loving heavenly Father and are given the opportunity to make the ultimate transformation by accepting Jesus as their Savior. Several of our children have made a decision to be baptized at Pathfinder camporees. They've been baptized while wearing their pathfinder uniforms!**
