This program consisted of an emergency placement center and three children's homes. These sisters thrived in the care of house parents who loved them and provided for their needs.

In June, Beti, married the love of her life, and recently, Anne-Marie completed her course work and will graduate with her degree in dentistry. As these young women take their place as productive members of society in Romania and maintain a firm faith in Jesus whom they love and serve, they have ICC family members like you to thank for the years of loving care they experienced.

In May, Jan and I were able to visit Anne-Marie and Beti and attend a reunion of the ICC Romania family. It was wonderful to see several of our grown children as well as dedicated care center staff and house parents. Warm embraces, smiles, and laughter filled the room.

As time passed, the crowd began to disperse. However, many of those who remained, who lingered basking in the moment, were the house parents and the children. They had bonded, lived together, ate together, worked together, solved problems together, and worshipped God together. They lingered because of a deep bond, because of love – the love of a family. It reaffirms that ICC's model of home-based care for children is ordained by God and blessed by God.

Project Spotlight – Los Pinos Children's Village, Guatemala

The Impact of Your Support

Large the month of August, families in the United States prepare for "back-to-school" season. New beginnings bring an air of excitement. Yet, for many children around the world, the thought of school brings feelings of insufficiency. Education is inaccessible to many impoverished children.

That's why, through your support, Los Pinos Children's Village currently opens its doors to local needy children. As a result, those who would otherwise be unable to attend school now have hope for a bright future.

An update from Joel Carpio, Los Pinos director, shows how your support is helping to lift children from poverty through education.

In Guatemala, the school year began during January. There are more than 60 children enrolled at the school, and 12 live on campus. For those living off campus, Los Pinos provides transportation on their minibus.

"This program provides an opportunity for primary-level education to children from low-income families ...," shares Joel Carpio, Los Pinos director. "Our home will be their support system, helping these children achieve their goals and access better opportunities."

Children at Los Pinos receive holistic education with handson learning. This includes intellectual development, as well as strengthening of everyday life skills and providing meaningful spiritual programs. In addition, school meals are provided, which may sometimes be the only meal that off-campus children receive.

Furthermore, children of all ages are blessed with the gift of education that you provide! Currently, 22 students attend ICAP, the neighboring secondary institution. Your support also provides for four "ICC kids" from Los Pinos to study at the university level in Guatemala City.

"Regardless of their grade level or age, we know they give their best effort to move forward, and we hope that more and more


